



## **CWA Local 4201 Officer Election Update**

There have been several questions surrounding the eligibility of U.S. Air members who work at locations within District 4, who will become members of Local 4201 as a result of the airline merger, to run for elected office in Local 4201. As a result of these inquiries, after a review by CWA Headquarters in Washington, D.C., it has been determined that those U.S. Air members based at locations in Illinois, Indiana, Ohio and Michigan are eligible to run for elected office in Local 4201.

As a result of this decision, and concerns of members regarding the initial mailing, it has been decided that the proper course of action is to void all petitions from the initial mailing and begin fresh with all eligible members participating. Therefore, a letter explaining the process, including how to request, complete and return nomination petitions will be mailed to all eligible members early next week. The letter will also contain a link to the By-Laws where duties of the elected positions can be viewed. If a member does not receive this letter by Monday, September 28<sup>th</sup> they can request another one be sent by contacting Lue Ann Pennington or Michelle Marley at 847-550-0797. They will verify that they have the correct address and send another letter.

I know this seems to be a long and onerous process but I think you will agree that the goal is to make sure the election is conducted in a manner that is fair to all participants. This update is an effort to keep members informed as to the status of the elections. Please continue to monitor this website for further updates. Thanks for your patience and understanding as we move forward.
